Re: Snow storms

As you are all aware, our area has recently experienced an abnormal amount of snow accumulation. This requires a certain amount of diligence on your part. It is imperative that all homeowners make sure that any and all vents for mechanical equipment are cleared of snow in order that they may function effectively. Houses today are built differently than years ago so please do not assume that you do not have to perform this chore.

Kindly examine the total perimeter of your home clearing away snow from all areas that are near a vent. These vents are placed at a height that has been determined for an average snow fall. We have already exceeded that amount and any further snow we will have this year will just add to this amount.

Also please inspect your gutters and downspouts for ice dams and snow build up to insure that water can drain away from your home. If necessary you will have to remove ice and snow so that water does not puddle near your home.

Safety should be everyone's main concern this winter and we thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
